

RULES

1. No liability is accepted by the organisers, New Forest Riding Club or its representatives for any loss, damage, accident or injury to any spectators, competitors, animals or property however caused.
2. The decisions of the Judges and organisers are final.
3. All mounted persons **MUST** wear proper protective headgear and it must comply to EN1384 or PAS015 or equivalent. The chin strap must be properly fastened when ever mounted. Failure to do so will result in immediate disqualification from show ground and all entry fees forfeited. Hats dislodged whilst competing will result in elimination from that class.
NOTE: This hat rule applies anywhere on the show ground.
4. Tests may be commanded.
5. Judged under BD Rules. Correct riding dress and tack must be worn: i.e. snaffle bridles with one noseband (cavesson, drop or flash). Double bridles may be used for the Elementary Test. English type saddle. No martingale, side, draw, bearing or running reins or Market Harborough permitted. No blinkers, hoods, neck straps, breastplates, cruppers and bit guards (smooth rubber only) are permitted. These restrictions apply whilst riders are competing and warming up. Competitors only are permitted to ride the horse.
6. **Competitors must be ready to ride their test up to 10 minutes before the allotted time.**
7. No entry fees will be refunded after the closing date.
8. The organisers reserve the right to alter or cancel a class or event due to such circumstances as very bad weather or unsafe riding conditions. In such an event the entry fees only will be refunded.
9. No galloping or dangerous behaviour of any kind permitted on the show grounds.
10. Gloves (any colour) must be worn whilst riding a dressage test unless for reasons of disability the inability to wear gloves is declared on the entry form.
11. Elimination will result if the test area is used for working in if rider can go outside the area.
12. All horses must be 4 years and over.
13. Horse/Rider combination may only enter 2 classes.
14. Anyone under 18 years old must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
15. Dogs must be kept on a lead.

CLASSES

- Class 1: **NOVICE ABILITY (2007)**
Restricted to horse/rider combination that have never been placed 1st in a novice ability riding test or placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any dressage competition. No Spurs allowed.
This will be judged as a dressage test.
- Class 2: **PRELIMINARY 14 (2006)**
Restricted to Horse/Rider combination not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in any dressage competition
- Class 3: **PRELIMINARY 12 (2005) Open**
- Class 4: **HAVE A GO PAIRS**
Find a Partner and ride Prelim 7 (2002) together – you don't have to match and dress the same – just ride the movements side by side. You can have a caller. It's just for fun – perhaps a taster for the Area Pairs Competition?
- Class 5: **NOVICE 24 (2010) Open**
- Class 6: **ELEMENTARY 44 (2002) Open**
