## Directions to the venue

*The Fortune Centre of Riding Therapy  
Avon Tyrrell, Bransgore, Christchurch, Dorset BH23 8EE*

From the A31 heading West to Bournemouth, take the Burley turn off at Picket Post Service Station. Follow the signs into Burley (about 3 miles). In the centre of the village you will find a triangular junction with a war memorial in the centre. Turn right (signposted for Avon Tyrrell). After a couple of miles you will rise up a hill and come to a crossroads at Thorney Hill. Turn right (signposted Avon Tyrrell). Go over the cattle grid, continue for 400m until you reach a left hand bend with a fork and a white cottage on the right. Turn right. The Fortune Centre is on the right.
