Please note that travel to and from an activity is not included nor are you covered if you are riding at non Riding Club activities. The policy also covers Employer's liability and land and access for any organised activities. Although we always hope we won't have to claim, such cover is very valuable. If by any chance you might be involved in a claim, never admit liability, never offer payment, collect witnesses' names and addresses and advise the insurer through the Club as soon as possible.
